



The Second Meeting of Creditors, to be on or about 10 July 2009, will be held subsequent to the issuance of a detailed report into the affairs of the Companies and the causes leading to the appointment of Administrators. At this meeting the future of the Companies will be decided, whereby creditors will vote as to whether the Companies will:

- a) enter liquidation and be wound up;
- b) be handed back to the directors; or
- c) execute a Deed of Company Arrangement.

The outcome of this meeting will directly affect the status of employee entitlements and their payment in liquidation under the General Employee Entitlements and Redundancy Scheme (GEERS) - please refer to the GEERS website for more information www.workplace.gov.au/geers. I recommend employees attend this meeting, of which notice will be included in the report.
