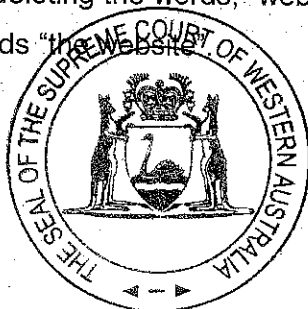

UPON the plaintiff's interlocutory process dated 14 June 2010 AND UPON HEARING Mr R W Douglas of counsel for the first to eighth plaintiffs, Mr D Solomon of counsel for those fourth defendants listed in Schedule A to the amended notice of appearance dated 12 May 2010 and listed in Schedule A to the further notice of appearance dated 12 May 2010, Mr J A Thomson of counsel for the 4065th fourth defendant and Ms Z Kelly of counsel for the first to third defendants on 15 and 25 June 2010 IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Minute of Further Amended Originating Process annexed and marked "A" to the plaintiffs' application dated 14 June 2010 stand as the Originating Process in these proceedings.
2. The Liquidators (in their capacity as liquidators of the first plaintiff) are justified in causing the first plaintiff including in its capacity as responsible entity of the Schemes (as that term is defined in Order 1 to the Orders of His Honour Justice Le Miere in these proceedings on 27 May 2010) to:
 - (a) assign, terminate, surrender or otherwise deal with the lease listed as item 7 in Schedule 5 to the Further Amended Originating Process (**Head Lease**) in return for a right of the first plaintiff including under any Scheme to assert a claim against the fund provided for in Order 6 of the Orders made in these proceedings on 27 May 2010; and
 - (b) upon any termination of, assignment of, surrender of, or dealing with the Head Lease by the second plaintiff, give vacant possession of the property listed as Item 3 in Schedule 3 Part 3 of the Further Amended Originating Process to the second plaintiff.
3. The Orders made by the Honourable Justice Le Miere on 27 May 2010 be varied such that in Order 2(a) the words "Amended Originating Process" be varied to "Further Amended Originating Process".
4. Order 2(b) made by Acting Master Chapman on 8 April 2010 be varied by deleting the words, "and the Great Southern Group".
5. Order 19 made by the Honourable Justice Le Miere made on 27 May 2010 be varied by deleting the words, "websites of the Great Southern Group and" and substituting the words "websites".
