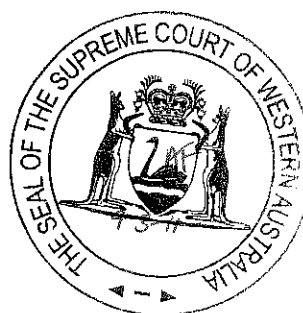

UPON HEARING Mr R W Douglas of Counsel for the first to eighth plaintiffs and Mr J Thomson of Counsel for the 4065th fourth defendant IT IS ORDERED THAT:

PLEADINGS

1. The 4065th Fourth Defendant (the **Bank**) comply with order 4 of the orders of Le Miere J made on 15 December 2010 (**15 December orders**), as varied by order 2 of the orders of Le Miere J made on 10 February 2011, by no later than 18 March 2011.
2. If the Bank fails to comply with order 1 above, paragraphs 16, 17, 47, 48, 49, 51, 54(b), 54(d), 54(e), 58, 59, 79(b), 79(c), 87(b), 88(b), 88(c), 88(d) and 98 of the Bank's defence be struck out.

DISCOVERY

3. The time for compliance with order 6 of the 15 December orders be extended to 25 March 2011.

LIBERTY TO APPLY

4. Nothing in the foregoing precludes any party from exercising his right to seek the re-listing of the matter for further directions at any time.

NEXT DIRECTIONS HEARING

5. The next directions hearing shall be at 9.15am on Tuesday, 29 March 2011.

COSTS

6. The Bank do pay the Plaintiffs' costs of and incidental to this directions hearing to be taxed if not agreed.
